



Tyc's Resort Boat Safety Checklist

Please and check supplied circles, provide the information required at the bottom of the document and sign.

I, the pleasure craft operator agree to the following:

- o Confirm that there are appropriate number and sizes of approved life jackets in the boat for the number of people on board. I am aware that persons operating a pleasure craft without the appropriate number and sizes of approved PDF's or Life Jackets may be subjected to ticking and/or a fine.
- o Am aware that it is illegal to operate a pleasure craft or to permit others to do so when under the influence of alcohol, narcotics or barbituates.
- o Will only allow people who have completed and signed Tyc's Resort Boat Safety Checklist, valid for the duration of this rental or have other proof of competency to operate this pleasure craft. I am aware that persons operating a pleasure craft without proof of competency/age, may be subjected to ticketing and/or a fine.
- o Have been shown how to use, and know the location of safety equipment required under the Small Vessel Regulations. I am aware that persons operating a pleasure craft without the required safety equipment may be subject to ticketing and/or a fine.
- o Understand that pleasure craft fitted with motors must keep clear of non-powered pleasure craft. I also understand that I am responsible for my own wake and wash and the effects that it can have on other pleasure craft, property, wildlife and the environment.
- o When involved in an accident must stop, offer assistance and give identity. I am aware that I am responsible for any damage to and loss of boat, motor and equipment during the rental.
- o Am aware of how to responsibly operate the pleasure craft and to share the waterways in a courteous and respectful manner with others involved in all water-related activity.
- o Have confirmed that the maximum load capacity and number of persons in the pleasure craft will not exceed the amount sated on the capacity plate.
- o Have been shown the proper procedure for starting and shutting off the engine if required and will make sure no person is in the water within the vicinity of the pleasure craft before starting and while the motor is running.
- o Have been shown and understand the operation of the throttle and gear-shift lever if required.
- o Know where and how to operate the ignition cut off (kill switch) if required.
- o Have a valid Canadian boaters licence if Canadian.

Local Hazards and Conditions

- o Am aware of the local navigational aids and their meaning, as well as local hazards and local regulations.
- o Shall maintain a proper lookout at all times for other boats, navigational hazards and changes in weather conditions.

Damages

- o Agree to be responsible for all damages to and loss of boat, motor and equipment during the rental of said items and any costs associated to injury of peoples related to accident.
